The MARC Solid Waste Management District encompasses Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte and Ray counties in Missouri. The Regional HHW Collection Program is designed to provide convenient access to proper HHW disposal for all district residents.

Residents of participating communities may take HHW products to the permanent collection facilities in Kansas City, Mo., and Lee's Summit\* at no charge. Proof of residency is required.

In addition, residents of participating communities may drop off HHW products at any of the mobile collections held throughout the year. **To find out exact locations for upcoming mobile collections, please call 816-474-TEAM.**

If you live within the MARC Solid Waste Management District and your city or county is not participating in the program, please contact your city council or county commission.
