

Sample Recycling Tips



Plastic caps are recyclable, but because they are small they can easily get lost in recycling equipment. To avoid this problem, leave caps on plastic bottles when you recycle them. You can also store plastic caps in a plastic jar. When the jar is full, toss it into a recycling bin.
